



Brian & Sara McIntosh

Brian D. McIntosh is a Naval Aviator, flying F-18C Hornets for the World Famous Blue Blasters of VFA-34 out of Virginia Beach, Virginia. He and his wife Sara, along with daughters Hailey and Fallon, work ACN part time around Brian's full time Navy career.

When first approached with ACN, Brian was both extraordinarily busy and in a peculiar financial situation. "We had just had our first child, and I was working 70 hours a week going through flight school with the Navy. I had a two hour round trip commute to work every day, and with a one month old in the house, no one was sleeping! Sara had left her job working as a research nurse, and we were living on 40% less income than before. It was hard, and nerves were frayed."

There could not have been a more inconvenient time for Brian and Sara to try and take on one more thing, but with the expenses of a new child, and the loss of Sara's income, Brian felt they had no choice. "I decided to join ACN out of desperation, and a clear desire to NEVER have to worry about money again. I wasn't sure that I would be able to make it work, with the time constraints, and the military being what it is...but I HAD to do something, and this just made sense. I went for it."

Brian worked to fit ACN into the cracks of his life wherever possible, and in 12 days, achieved the position of ETT. Having created a business that could replace Sara's income, the McIntosh's were free from the worries of the lost income, and had hopes of a bright future with ACN. "We retired Sara from a career that took her 16 years of school and 10 years to work up to, and we did it in 3 months...part time!! I never would have thought that this opportunity could have such dramatic impact on my life so quickly. I am still amazed every day."

Today Brian and Sara have 2 children and are Team Coordinators in ACN. After 4 years in with the company, they are knocking on the door to Regional Vice President, and still working ACN part-time. "We're going to make RVP in the fall of next year, and I still can't believe it. This kind of business was something that always worked for others, but not me. I guess I was wrong. It works for anyone...anyone who wants change badly enough. If you have a burning desire to make a real change in your life, and you are given the resources to make that change, there is no reason or excuse that can stop you from accomplishing your goals. You need a reason and a track to run on...that's it." Brian will complete his obligation to the United States Navy in October of 2012. He will never work for another human being ever again.

"What we have been able to accomplish in the last 4 years is remarkable, but I can't take the credit. There is an unbelievable system already in place, and if you just follow it, you can't lose. Anyone can do this...you just have to want to. Financial freedom in 5 years...around 2 cross country moves, the birth of 2 children, a full-time navy career including 2 deployments and countless month long detachments...and every other thing that life throws at you. There are no excuses..."
